Saturday, September 25th will be the first day of competition beginning at 9:00 AM. Demonstration teams, breaking, weapons, and all poomsae competitions will be held.

Sunday, September 26th will be the second day of competition and will also begin at 9:00 AM. All sparring competitions will be held this day.

Daedo PSS Scoring for ALL sparring competitors

ALL sparring competitors will use Daedo PSS hogus. This will require that all sparring competitors have Gen 2 Daedo electronic scoring socks. Electronic chest guards will be provided. Electronic head gear will be provided for those divisions with scoring head kicks (Cadet black belts and above).

Competition Rules

Unless called out and overridden elsewhere in this document, the Texas State Championship will follow the USAT Divisions and Rules. You can find all of those rules using this link:

This event will have two days of competitions.

Day 1 (Saturday, September 25th)

- All Poomsae competitions
- All Weapons competitions
- All Breaking competitions
- All Demonstration Team competitions

Note: For Poomsae, all color belt and 6-11 year old Black Belt divisions have only two rounds, prelim and final. For any division with more than 9 competitors, the top 8 competitors will advance to the final round. For any division with less than 9 competitors, all competitors will advance straight to the final round. Competitors will perform one Poomsae for prelim and one Poomsae for the final round. Designated Poomsae will be released closer to the tournament date.

All the other black belt divisions (individual, pairs and teams) will do WT cut off format performing one Poomsae for prelim, one Poomsae for semi-final round and two Poomsae for the final round. Designated Poomsae will be released closer to the tournament date.

All board breaking competitors must use boards provided by TXTKD and must be purchased at the time of Credential Pickup. Each board is \$3.00. **Cash only please.** All competitors will use 8"x10"x.25" boards. A maximum of 15 boards can be used.

Day 2 (Sunday, September 26th)

- All Sparring competitions

Weigh-ins are required for all Black Belt Cadets (12-14), Juniors (15-17), and Seniors (18-32)

Weigh-ins will be held on Saturday, September 25th from 9:00 AM to 12:00PM and 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM at the convention center.

All registrations must have been completed online PRIOR to the event. There will be NO onsite registrations accepted.

Competition Fees

- 1) \$100 for one event and \$20 any additional events before 11:59pm Central Time Tuesday, September 10, 2021.
- 2) Add \$50 late fee if registration occurs after 11:59pm Central Time Tuesday, September 10, 2021.
- 3) All Online Registration will be cut off at 11:59pm Central Time Tuesday, September 21, 2020.
- 4) Online Registration through is MANDATORY at tourneygo.com/txchamp
- 5) NO paper registrations accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 6) NO door registrations accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Credential Pick up & Weigh-Ins

Credential pickup will be the evening of Friday, September 24th from 6:00 PM until 10:00. Credential pickup will continue from 9:00 AM until 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM until 4:00 PM on Saturday, September 25th.

If you are a Black Belt sparring competitor Cadet (12-14), Junior (15-17), or Senior (18-32), a weigh-in must be completed on Saturday, September 25th between 9:00 AM and 12:00 PM or 1:00 PM and 4:00PM. All credential pickup and weigh-ins will occur at the Fort Worth Convention Center.

Equipment, Awards, and Hotels

Mandatory Equipment

WT approved V-neck uniform only (no color trim except on black belt v-neck).

All sparring competitors must wear (WT approved):

- White or red or blue headgear (red & blue headgear must be matched with chest protector color) when not provided PSS headgear
- Red and blue reversible chest protector (hogu)
- Forearm guards
- Shin and instep guards
- Groin cup (male AND females, worn inside)
- White or Transparent Mouthpiece

- Ages 12-32 Black Belt Sparring competitors must also wear WT approved TKD Gloves
- All sparring competitors must provide their own Gen 2 Daedo electronic socks.

TXTKD will provide electronic chest guards (hogus) for all divisions. Electronic headgear will be provided for those divisions with scoring head shots (Cadet black belt and above).

Competitor Awards

Medals will be awarded to one 1st, one 2nd and two 3rd place winners.
